

אנחנו תומכים ב'גוש שלום'

זה כמה שבועות נערכת התקפה על תנועת "גוש שלום" בגלל מאמציה להביא לתודעת קציני צה"ל את התוצאות האפשריות מביצוע פעולות העלולות להיחשב כפשעי-מלחמה על פי אמנת ז'נבה הרביעית, שישראל התומה עליה.

לפי החוק הישראלי, יש "פקודות בלתי-חוקיות בעליל", שעליהן מתנופף הדגל השחור של אי-החוקיות. החיילים חייבים לסרב למלא פקודות כאלה, כגון: הוצאה-להורג ללא משפט ("המכונה "חיסול"), הריגת פצועים חסרי-ישע (המכונה "וידוא הריגה"), מניעת הגישה של צוותות רפואיים לפצועים, ירי באמבולנסים ובצוותים רפואיים, הרעבת אוכלוסיות, הטלת פצצות על אזורי-מגורים, הריסה המונית של בתים, הענשת משפחות על מעשיו של אחד מבני-המישפחה (גירוש והריסת בית).

לפי אמנת ז'נבה הרביעית, יש להביא מבצעי פקודות בלתי-חוקיות בשטחים הכבושים (פשעי מלחמה) למשפט בבית-משפט ישראלי או בינלאומי. "גוש שלום" מנסה למנוע ביצוע של פשעי-מלחמה על-ידי אוזרת קציני וחיילי צה"ל מפני אפשרות זו.

במקום לגנות את "גוש שלום", היו ראש-הממשלה אריאל שרון ושר-המישפטים מאיר שיטרית צריכים להודות ל"גוש שלום" על עמדתו האמיצה. הם היו צריכים לנקוט כל אמצעי אפשרי כדי להבטיח שחיילים וחיילות לא יידרשו עוד לבצע פקודות בלתי-חוקיות בעליל.

"גוש שלום" מנסה לקדם את מיטב האינטרסים של מדינת ישראל והשלום. אנחנו, החתומים מטה, התומכים בשלום צודק, בטוח ובר-קיימא בין ישראל והפלסטינים, תומכים ב"גוש שלום", המזהיר את אזרחי ישראל מפני התוצאות הרות-האסון של הכיבוש.
